The more complex answer:

NLP Trainer IANLP

Are highly competent **NLP professionals** who

- successfully use nlp tools in group settings,
- such as when **providing training, teaching courses, meetings**, or in the course of their activities in **educational settings**.

Hence, the NLP Trainer Training does not prepare individuals for teaching NLP tools. It rather prepares individuals to employ NLP tools to foster group processes and to promote learning.

Fellow Member Trainer IANLP

Professional, advanced requirements

- Are **NLP Teaching Trainers**, they teach NLP, and they
- **may seal their certificates** with the sticker seal of the IANLP.



NLP Trainer IANLP *and/or* Fellow Member Trainer IANLP

Conclusion

NLP Trainer Training IANLP

- is a training in NLP-based presentational skills,
- to be used in various and diverse fields of application.

The recognition as a Fellow Member Trainer IANLP is not a goal of the NLP Trainer Training.



Only a vanishingly small percentage of certified NLP Trainers shall become FMT.

Professional, advanced requirements

...and... limited market.

An ethical observation

In the view of fair and transparent communication, it is good practice to point out to the students (at an early stage), that the training goal '*Fellow Member Trainer*' usually ends up in an already saturated market.

Note:
Becoming FMT should not be goal of NLP Training.

- ★ Assisted in 2 NLP Master, plus
- ★ Attended regular Supervision.

Level 100 Use Agreement for **experienced** NLP Teaching Trainers

Entitled to

- ★ Certify all levels (special obligations for NLP Trainer training apply)

Definition of the IANLP encompasses **diversity of applications.**

NLP is beneficial for:

- ★ Education, Training, Presentation
- ★ Family, Parenting

it's **Professionals !!**

The IANLP views training in NLP as an education that adds competence to *any existing* field of professional activity.

In most countries NLP training does **not** prepare for a professional state or federal license or constitute for such.

Good to know:

- ★ Recently '*NLP Practitioner*' has been established as an official *counseling profession* in the UK. – This is in contradiction to IANLP's definition of NLP Practitioner.
- ★ Some NLP schools have managed to get their NLP trainings accredited by official (state) authorities.

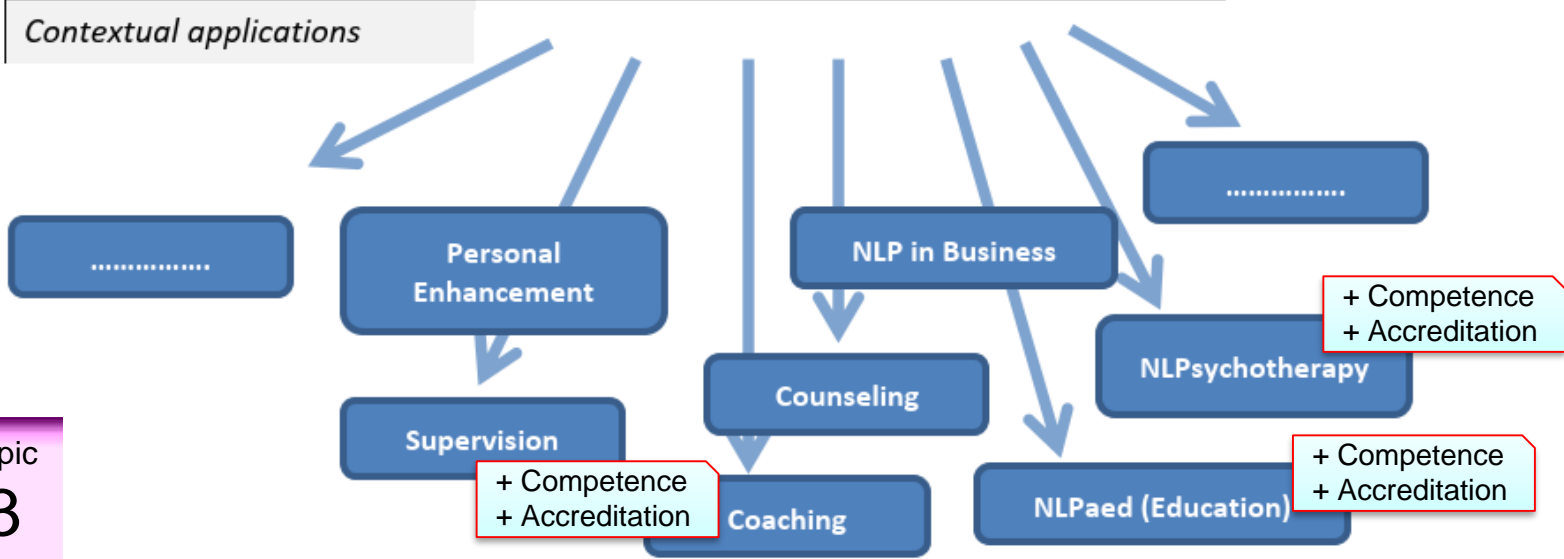

IANLP's definition (overview)

Epistemology of NLP	A codified set of patterns, (model) created through the process of NLP modelling, which can then be transferred to other people so they achieve the same results as the exemplar.
Model developments (new filters) are examples of the products of NLP epistemology	Anchoring, Reframing, Submodalities, Timeline, T.O.T.E., Associated/Disassociated, Milton language, Metamodell of language, and more.
NLP processes and techniques	Change History, 6-Step-Reframing, Chaining, Wellformed Outcome, Rapport, Mikroskills (non-verbals)...

Modelling is the methodology of NLP.

Modelling is how NLP practitioners explore the structure of the subjective experience of experts in their field which, through training, can then be transferred to other people.
